He came in and sat in the second seat from the front, well; people moved that was close around him. In the meantime Pastor Harry continued to preach, {for those of you who knew Pastor Harry, he could preach up a storm} We looked at each other thinking, how would Pastor Harry go now, after he preached a powerful message in the morning on “loving the unlovely” He stopped preaching, then came the Alter call, {If anyone would like to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour come out now} The first one out was this young man, { we are thinking this will test his message out from the morning service} Let me tell you; with tears in his eyes; Dad, my father in law, went over to this young man put his arms around him and hugged him; he said Jesus loves you man and so do we. Young Gerry, run for the door, he went { bang – bang} down the stairs out into the street, looked up and down, looked up the lane way near the Church, the young man could not be found anywhere. Gerry came back and said to me “Pastor Les! I can not find him anywhere” let me tell you there was a reverence silence over that cuppa that night. I believe we had a visitation from Heaven that night. There was such a respect in all our meetings from then on. I will in the future newsletters tell you of some other times when drunks were in the meetings, went to the front to receive Jesus as Lord and Saviour, walked back from the Alter totally sober.
