Luke 6:46-49

“Why do you call me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and still don’t do what I say?

Some people come to me and listen to me and do what I say. I will show you what they are like. They are like someone who builds a house. He digs down deep and sets it on solid rock. When a flood comes, the river rushes against the house. But the water can’t shake it. The house is well built. “But here is what happens when people listen to my words and do not obey them. They are like someone who builds a house on soft ground instead of solid rock. The moment the river rushes against that house, it falls down. It is completely destroyed

I can’t overestimate the importance of a solid foundation. If a building is to be useful, sturdy and permanent , it must have a solid base. This is one of those facts which everyone agrees with. Wherever men erect buildings, they must pay attention to the foundation. Since this is something understood by all men. God has used it to teach us Devine truth. A foundation supports a building, each part of the building depends on the foundation. The Bible speaks of our lives as a building and tells us of the Kind of foundation upon which we must build. The Bible also speaks of the Church as a building, and tells us the foundation upon which it must be built.

1. What makes a sound life...[v. 47]
 - a. Who ever comes to me.
 - b. Hears My sayings.
 - c. Does them.
2. Can one hear and not do. [v. 46]
 - a. You call Me Lord, Lord.
 - b. You do not the things which I say.
 - c. This is knowing the Word and not doing it.
3. What is a man like who hears and does the Word [v. 48]
 - a. Like a man which builds a house.
 - b. Diggs deep.

- c. Laid the foundation on a “Rock”
 - d. He “dugged deep” he removed everything between him and the Rock he made sure that he had a solid footing.
4. Why must the house be build “On a Rock”
- a. The flood rose and the stream beat strong upon the house.
 - b. It is the nature of life to be stormy.
 - c. Nobody escapes the storm.
5. What happened to the house on a Rock [v. 48]
- a. The Storm could not shake it.
 - b. For it was founded upon a Rock.
 - c. There will be storms in your Christian life, but if you are hearing and doing the Word of God the storm can’t shake you.
6. What is the danger in building our lives on the sand. [v. 49]
- a. He that hears and does not.
 - b. A man with out a foundation.
 - c. Built upon the ground.
7. What happened to the house without a foundation.
- a. The storm did beat hard [same storm]
 - b. Immediately it fell.
 - c. The ruin of that house was great.

We cannot “go on unto perfection” unless the foundations have been laid right. This is why so many Christians do not grow and mature, their foundation is not sound, Once the foundation is properly laid then we must go on.

Isaiah 28:16 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner [stone], a sure foundation:
